Edicule and Urban Chateau Glam Up for *Hollywood Style* · Neiman Marcus Salutes Boaz Mazor

A Tinseltown-style searchlight beckoned glam guests to the carpeted sidewalks leading into Edicule and Urban Chateau on upper Sacramento Street for a night of carousing in the spirit of the Rat Pack days. A 1953 Rolls-Royce Silver Wraith was parked in front of Urban Chateau, where owner **Terry Gross** welcomed guests, along with Marilyn Monroe (aka **Christina Kramlich**) in a vintage Lagerfeld top and Adolfo skirt) and Joan Crawford (aka **Samantha Weaver**). Holding court in the store was author and *PaperCity* interior design editor **Diane Dorrans Sacks**, signing her latest book, *Hollywood Style* (Rizzoli). On another lovely day, downtown at a Neiman Marcus luncheon, general manager **John Capizzi** and fashion-savvy **Sally Debenham** honored Oscar de la Renta's right-hand man, **Boaz Mazor**.
